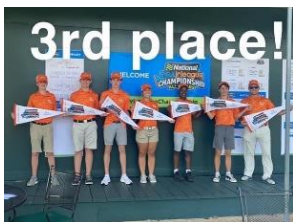
MAINTENANCE News
